Her work explores bodies of water as physical, cultural, and unique environmental 'landscapes'. Carters practice investigates our often- complex psychological relationship to water through different perspectives and geographical locations, utilising digital collaging to create new ways of experiencing these spaces.

Through the use of intimate perspective, Cathy seeks to embody 'seeing' as an experience rather than solely as an observation. As spaces of isolation and destabilization, the bodies of water depicted in her work offer sensuous and psychologically-compelling encounters. This suggests human vulnerability in these environments, as well as the vulnerability of our oceans and waterways at this time in history.

Carter graduated from AUT University with a Master of Art and Design (Hons) in 2013 and has exhibited regularly throughout New Zealand and Australia since. Cathy has been a regular finalist in a number of international competitions – most recently four-times as a finalist in the Wallace Art Awards (2019, 2018, 2017, 2016 & 2014), the International HeadOn Portrait Prize (2019, 2018, 2016 & 2015) and the Walker and Hall Waiheke Art Prize (2019, 2018, 2017 & 2016).

Carter's work is held in a number of distinguished public, private and corporate collections including The Wallace Arts Trust, The Parliamentary Art Collection and the Fisher Trust in New Zealand.
